Members are to consider and determine a response to the suggested proposal put forward as an alternative to Waveney's Local Plan by Badger Building  Councillor Tyler gave a statement of events so far. Dialogue had taken place with Badger Building around their proposals to suggest an alternative to the proposed local plan of 900 houses on land off the Street. They suggested that this development was unsuitable and proposed a smaller development on land to the west of Carlton Colville which would see the triangle of land remain as an area of green space. Around 300 houses could be built along with some junction and safety improvements to take traffic away from the Street and join up with major roads more quickly. This plan is only at a high level stage and will go before the Inspector of the Waveney Local Plan in October. <b>It proposed by Councillor Radforth, seconded by Councillor Fair and RESOLVED by ALL to accept the proposals by Badger building and submit a joint statement to the Waveney Local Plan inspector.</b>
